INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Conditions of Play

The competition will be held in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and Local Rules as approved by the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Entry Requirements

Open to Amateurs who are members of a Golf Club affiliated to the South African Golf Association and who have a handicap index of 9.9 or less as assessed in terms of the SAGA Course Rating and Handicapping System or other system acceptable to the South African Golf Association and all players who qualify in terms of the below Exemption categories.

Field Size

Entries will be limited to 120 players. Should more than 120 entries be received, entries will be reduced by the Tournament Organizing Committee based on the SAGA Rankings, higher handicaps or by means they deem to be fair. **Exemption Categories:**

Entrants who are exempt from a ballot will be:

- a) International players as accepted by the Southern Cape Golf Union,
- Players who competed in the A Division of the 2019 Premier Inter Provincial Tournament, b)
- The Top 50 players on the SAGA Player Ranking list as of Monday 10th February 2020, C)
- d) Ten (10) Development players as determined by the Tournament Organising Committee.

Form of Competition

The tournament is played over three days. Eighteen (18) holes will be played on Monday 24th February 2020 at George Golf Club and on Tuesday 25th February 2020 at Kingswood Golf Estate. Thereafter the field will be cut to 65 players and ties. Thirty-six (36) holes will be played on Wednesday 26th February 2020 at Kingswood Golf Estate. In the event of a tie for the championship, a sudden death play-off will take place over hole 1 until the winner is determined. Entries

The entry fee is R950, and entries will close at 12h00 on Monday 10th February 2020. Online entries and payment must be completed before the closing date, and all information required must be provided accurately. No telephonic, telegraphic or email entries will be accepted. The onus is on the player to ensure that his entry has been received by SCGU as prescribed in these Conditions.

Withdrawals

Only written or faxed cancellation will be accepted and if received after the closing date no refund will be made. **Draw & Starting Times**

The draw will be conducted by the Southern Cape Golf Union. Any competitor who is absent from the tee when called upon to start will be liable to disqualification or penalty under Rule 5-3a. The draw will be available on Wednesday 12th February 2020 at Kingswood, George Golf Club, the GolfRSA www.golfrsa.com, Southern Cape Golf Union's office and on the Unions web site www.scgu.co.za. It is the player's responsibility to obtain his tee-off time.

Registration

All participating players must register at least 30 minutes prior to their tee off time on Monday 24th February 2020. The registration areas will be located at the Clubhouse entrance of George Golf Club.

*Breach of this condition will result in disqualification.

Decisions

Decisions and disputes of any kind will be dealt with by the Tournament Committee of the Southern Cape Golf Union. <u>Practice Rounds & Practice Area</u>

Limited tee times are available on Sunday 23rd February 2020 at both Kingswood Golf Estate and George Golf Club, with a special rate of R250 applying to all entrants. Contact Kingswood Golf Estate on +27 (0)86 172 7170 and George Golf Club on +27 (0)44 873 6116 for any practice round bookings. The Official driving range is located at Kingswood Golf Estate, and range balls will be for your own account. Both Kingswood Golf Estate and George Golf Club have putting and chipping green facilities.

Caddies

This will be the Players responsibility. All Players must arrange for caddies or permission for outside caddies with Kingswood Golf Estate & George Golf Club. All caddies must have their I.D Documentation on them for the security gate at Kingswood Golf Estate. It will be the Players responsibility to look after their caddie.

Dress Code a) Soft spikes.

- b) Golf specific shorts will be allowed. Shorts must be knee length and cargo or draw string shorts are not permitted.
- c) Only recognised golf attire will be allowed. No collarless shirts.

Distance Measuring Devices (D.M.D's)

For the duration of the tournament a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 4-3a(1).

*Penalty for breach of Rule 4-3a(1): First offence: Two Strokes, Second offence: Disqualification

Prize Giving

The Southern Cape Golf Union hereby requests that all competing players please attend the prize giving on Wednesday 26th February 2020. Failure to attend will lead to players forfeiting their prize. Your respect towards the above request will be much appreciated.

<u>General</u>

A request is made to all players to please respect the courtesy granted by Kingswood Golf Estate and George Golf Club by undertaking to repair all divots and pitch marks, and not to litter the golf course and surrounds. Sandbags will also be compulsory for this tournament.

Exemption of Liability

The Southern Cape Golf Union, Host Club and Facility, SAGA & GolfRSA and their management will not be held responsible for any damages, loss, including;

Personal loss and or other forms of loss, harm or injury sustained as stipulated below:

- a) Physical and/or emotional injuries suffered during the tournament/championship, due to any acts of God, suffered as a direct result thereof, including aspects such as being struck by lightning, etc.
- b) Physical injuries of any kind suffered by any person, including a player or spectator sustained by own negligence, or otherwise.
- c) Emotional injuries sustained due to any loss, including death, suffered because of any of the above injuries sustained personally or by a spectator.
- d) Damages suffered to any property of a player.
- e) The player acknowledges the exemption of liability of the Union and its management as listed above when he signs the acknowledgement or agrees to the Conditions of Entry. He also acknowledges the contents of the above, he understands it, and exempts the Southern Cape Golf Union, Host Club and Facility, SAGA & GolfRSA from any liability as indicated above.
