Newsletter Covid-19 (Affiliated Golfers)

30 June 2020

On behalf of the Southern Cape Golf Union, I wish to update you on the matters below and how we will handle events in the near future.

- Tournaments (Union Opens & League) All tournaments run by Southern Cape Golf Union between 18 March 2020 and 31 July 2020 will be cancelled or postponed where possible.
  - All Opens up until end of July have been cancelled. Please download the updated SCGU Fixture List on our website. (www.scgu.co.za)
  - Motus Group Handicaps League for 2020 will be cancelled.
  - Motus Group Senior Super League for 2020 will be cancelled.
  - Southern Cape Super League TBC
  - Women's League Cancelled for 2020

Handicap & Senior League team entry fees received will be carried over to next year.

Tournaments beyond 31 July will be reconsidered for continuation or cancellation on a rolling basis with due consideration of the prevailing situation around the Corona National Disaster at that time.

- Local Events 30 Days prior to event.
- National Events 60 Days prior to event.
- Southern Cape Open & Southern Cape Women's Open have been postponed. Date to be announced.
- Inter Provincial Tournaments All inter provincial tournaments for 2020 have been cancelled by GolfRSA.

We have chosen to align ourselves with the national body when it comes to the procedure and timeline when cancelling events.
