INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Conditions of Play

The competition will be held in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and Local Rules as approved by the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Entry Requirements

Open to Amateurs who are older than **50** (Fifty) years of age, and members of a Golf Club affiliated to the Southern Cape Golf Union and who have a handicap index of **29.3** or less as assessed in terms of the SAGA Course Rating and Handicapping System. Players must be **50** (fifty) years of age on the start date of the tournament.

Entries

Entries will be limited to 80 players. Should more than 80 entries be received, entries will be reduced by ballot in terms of higher handicaps.

Form of Competition

The tournament is played over one day. 18 holes will be played on Saturday 26th June 2021 at Mossel bay Golf Club. All players will enter using their Handicap index, and our Scoring Program will then calculate your Course Handicap on the morning of play.

The Divisions will be as follow:

- A Division (6.5 Less Handicap Index)-Medal Stableford
- B Division (6.6 15.3 Handicap Index) -Medal Stableford
- C Division (15.4 29.3 Handicap Index)-Individual Stableford

In the event of a tie for the championship, the "Title" will be shared. All other count outs will be done using the R&A Tournament count out method. This will be done via the Albatros Scoring Program that will be used during the 2020 OOM season. SCGU will also be sending an official scorer to this Senior Open.

Entry Procedure

Please enter online via our website www.scgu.co.za. Alternatively, entry forms are obtainable from Mossel Bay Golf Club, Secretaries of Affiliated Golf Clubs, and the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Closing date

Entries close at 12h00 on Wednesday 23rd June 2021. Late entries and entries without payment or payment arrangement will not be accepted.

Withdrawals

Only written or faxed cancellation will be accepted and if received after the closing date no refund will be made.

Draw & Starting Times

Any competitor who is absent from the tee when called upon to start will be liable to disqualification or penalty under Rule 5-3a. The draw will be available at Mossel bay Golf Club, the Southern Cape Golf Union's office and on the Unions web site www.scgu.co.za by Wednesday 23rd June 2021. It is the player's responsibility to obtain his tee-off time.

Registration

All participating players must register at least 30 minutes prior to their tee off time on Saturday 26th June 2021.

The registration area will be located in the entrance / bar area of the Club House.

*Breach of this condition will result in disqualification.

Decisions

Decisions and disputes of any kind will be dealt with by the Tournament Committee of the Southern Cape Golf Union.

Declaration

All players will be required to sign a declaration form that they have been symptom free for a period of 10 consecutive days prior to the event.

Practice Area

All competing players will be allowed to use the Mossel Bay driving range & warm up area prior to their round. Range balls will be for your own account and are available for purchase inside the Pro Shop. The driving range is located in close proximity to the Clubhouse.

Meals

Halfway house will be a grab and go. Halfway House is for the players' own account.

Golf Carts

(A-Division Players): Golf carts are not allowed to be used by competing A-Division players. No such Players bag is allowed on a golf cart.

(B&C-Division Players): All B-Division players will be allowed the use of a golf cart for the day. Kindly contact the Mossel Bay GOLF Club on 044 691 2379 to book your own golf cart for the day.

Caddies

In the event of a player making use of the services of a caddie, the player always ensures that both they and the caddie regularly make use of sanitizers AND wear a mask where social distancing is not possible.

In addition, we propose that where the facilities do not allow caddies as caddies, that each match take a caddie that serves as a spotter / bunker raker etc with them. Cost to be shared by the group.

Spectators

No spectators (including parents) will be allowed on the golf course.

Dress Code

- a) Soft spikes.
- b) Golf specific shorts will be allowed. Shorts must be knee length and cargo or draw string shorts are not permitted.
- c) Only recognised golf attire will be allowed. No collarless shirts.

Distance Measuring Devices (D.M. D's)

For the duration of the tournament a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 4-3a (1).

*Penalty for breach of Rule 4-3a (1): First offence: Two Strokes, Second offence: Disqualification Prize Giving

There will be no prize giving after play, winners will be announced on social media and via email.

General

A request is made to all players to please respect the courtesy granted by Mossel Bay Golf Club by undertaking to repair all divots and pitch marks, and not to litter the golf course and surrounds. Sandbags will also be compulsory for this tournament.

Exemption of Liability

The Southern Cape Golf Union, Host Club and Facility, SAGA & GolfRSA and their management will not be held responsible for any damages, loss, or reckless behaviour of a player. Failure to follow the GolfRSA Covid-19 guidelines may result in disqualification.

Personal loss and or other forms of loss, harm or injury sustained as stipulated below:

- a) Physical and/or emotional injuries suffered during the tournament/championship, due to any acts of God, suffered as a direct result thereof, including aspects such as being struck by lightning, etc.
- b) Physical injuries of any kind suffered by any person, including a player or spectator sustained by own negligence, or otherwise.
- c) Emotional injuries sustained due to any loss, including death, suffered because of any of the above injuries sustained personally or by a spectator.
- d) Damages suffered to any property of a player.
- e) The player acknowledges the exemption of liability of the Union and its management as listed above when he signs the acknowledgement or agrees to the Conditions of Entry. He also acknowledges the contents of the above, he understands it, and exempts the Southern Cape Golf Union, Host Club and Facility, SAGA & GolfRSA from any liability as indicated above.
