### **TOURNAMENTS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR**

The Southern Cape Mixed was held on the 11<sup>th</sup> of February at Oubaai. We had a total of 72 players and most of our local clubs were represented. This year we had 3 divisions. The winners of the C Division were Chris Wood and Elsie Grobler, the B Division was won by Willie and Rejeanne Smit and the A Division champions were Ian Norgarb and Esme Orr. Thank you to all who played and congratulations to the winners.

The Sanlam SA Strokeplay was held at Port Elizabeth Golf Club in March and the Southern Cape was represented by six players. Azelia Meichtry was tied 5<sup>th</sup> and Sandra Winter finished 18<sup>th</sup> out of a field of 84.

In May Sandra Winter (Captain), Ethel Ruthenberg and Zane Naude represented Southern Cape at Waterkloof Golf Club for the 72 Hole Teams Championship. The team finished a respectable 6<sup>th</sup> in the A Division.

The Southern Cape Mid-Amateur and Senior Championship were held at Goose Valley in June. Forty Four players from 23 clubs entered. This year there were three divisions and the winners were: Melinda McCay in the C division, Esme Orr in the B Division and the Mid-Amateur champion was Sandra Winter.

Sheila Fraser was our Chaperone for the Nomads SA Girls Championship in Orkney. The girls selected to play were Zane Naude – Captain, Kira Kapeller, Sylken-Lee November, Chloe Malgas and Lize Marie Prinsloo. Well done to Zane Naude who finished tied 11 in the A division. Thank you Sheila for looking after the girls, and thank you to the girls for being such good ambassadors for the Southern Cape.

The Southern Cape Amateur Open and Junior Championship were held at Knysna Golf Club in September, sadly with a field of only 29 players. 16 of which were from the Southern Cape. The winner of the C division was Bev Pienaar from Knysna; Ineke Brynard was the winner of the open and junior B division. It was an exciting finish in the A division with a play off between Kaiyuree Moodley and Kaylah Williams, with Kaiyuree winning the junior and open division on the 20<sup>th</sup> hole.

This year the SA Women's Inter Provincial was held at Devonvale Golf and Wine Estate in Stellenbosch. The Southern Cape team consisted of Sandra Winter (Captain), Zane Naude, Ethel Ruthenberg, Kim de Klerk, Carey Dodds and Sylken Leigh November, who were our two rookies. The first day of play was the stroke play seeding round and the team once again managed to retain a top four finish which ensured our retention in the A division.
